



CVCC Friday Evening Couples Event Formats

Scramble

4 player teams, all players tee off, choose which shot is best and all play their next shots from the location of the best shot. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Play continues in this fashion for all of the 9 holes. Must use each player's tee shot at least once.

Odd/Even Scramble

4 player teams, all teams must utilize at least 1 tee shot from each player, subtract team's gross score from team handicap at the completion of the round, Women's tee shots will be used on odd holes, Men's tee shots will be used on even holes. Men will only putt on odd holes; women will only putt on even holes.

(Team handicap will be calculated as follows: add all four 18 hole player handicaps, divide by 8, multiply by 80%)

Shamble

4 player teams, all players hit each tee shot, select the best tee shot, all players play their own ball from that tee shot, all teams must utilize at least 1 tee shot from each player, teams will count 2 net better balls of 4 on every hole using 50% of their 18 hole handicap

Alternate Shot

4 player teams, each couple will each hit tee shots on every hole, select the best tee shot amongst the two tee shots, alternate from that point until the ball is holed out (ex: if wife's tee ball is chosen, husband will hit the 2nd shot, wife will hit 3rd, etc...), after each couple holes out on the hole add the two gross scores together for one team score, subtract team's gross score from team handicap at the completion of the round

(Team handicap will be calculated as follows: add all four player handicaps, divide by 8, multiply by 75%)

String Scramble

4 player teams, teams will play scramble format as stated above, each team will receive 10' of string and 1 pair of scissors, teams may use string to 'count' previous shot as 'holed out' (ex: team misses a twelve foot putt and has a 15 inch putt left, team may cut off 15 inches of string and count the previous 12 foot putt as holed out), continue to do this until all string is used up. Each player's tee shot must be used at least once.

Odd/Even String Scramble

4 player teams, teams will play scramble format as stated above, each team will receive 10' of string and 1 pair of scissors, teams may use string to 'count' previous shot as 'holed out' (ex: team misses a twelve foot putt and has a 15 inch putt left, team may cut off 15 inches of string and count the previous 12 foot putt as holed out), continue to do this until all string is used up. Women's tee shot will be used on odd holes. Men's tee shots will be used on even holes. Men will only putt on odd holes; women will only putt on even holes.

Gamble Scramble

4 player teams, each member receives a number corresponding to their position on the score card (first line #1, 2nd line #2, 3rd line #3, etc) teams will play a scramble format, after the tee shots are all played, one player rolls a 6-sided die and the number that comes up determines which tee shot the team has to use for that hole. (Example if #2 is rolled, then everyone picks up their ball and moves it to the location of #2's drive, all play from that spot) If a #5 or #6 is rolled then the game reverts to a regular scramble for that hole only; balls are placed at the location of the most advantageous drive. After the tee shot normal scramble rules prevail for the remainder of that hole. Repeat for all holes.

Florida Scramble

4 player teams, all players tee off. The best drive is selected. (Example Player A's drive is the best, all players move their balls to the location of Player A's drive). Player A does not play the next stroke, only Player B,C,&D hit second strokes. After the best second shot is determined, all players move their ball to that location and prepare for the next shot. Player A rejoins the group and the player whose second shot was used sits out the third shot. Repeat until the team reaches the green, then all players will putt.

Miami Scramble

4 Player teams, all players tee off. The best drive is selected (Example Player A's drive is the best, all players move their balls to the location of Player A's drive). Similar to Florida Scramble except Player A does not play again until the group reaches the green and then will rejoin the group and putt. Repeat for each hole.

All teams will play the same side each Friday as designated by the Couples Schedule.

When playing the back 9 with all Scramble, Shamble and String Scramble formats... all teams will play the lower green #12 and use the red tees on #13, all other holes players will play their normal tees.
