

FRIDAY COUPLES LEAGUE

2 Person Scramble:

2 player teams, both players tee off, choose which shot is best and both play their next shots from the location of the best shot. The other team member pick up their ball and places it within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Play continues in this fashion for all of the 9 holes. Must use each player's tee shot atleast once.

Gamble Scramble:

4 player teams, each member receives a number corresponding to their position on the score card. After the tee shots are all played, one player rolls a 6-sided die and the number that comes up determines which tee shot the team uses for that hole. If a 5 or 6 is rolled then the game reverts to a regular scramble for that hole only. After the tee shot normal scramble rules are in effect for the rest of the hole. Repeat for all holes.

Red, White, Blue Scramble:

4 player teams, mens tee boxes are determine by which hole you are on in order of Red, White, then Blue. (Red tee on 9, White tee on 10, Blue tee on 11, etc). Ladies and seniors will tee off from the American Flags. After the tee shot normal scramble rules are in effect for the rest of the hole.

Cluster Scramble:

4 player teams, each member receives a number corresponding to their position on the score card. Each hole will be a different format (will be provided on score card). All holes will be a scramble but partners will be mixed. Normal scramble rules are in effect.

Florida Scramble:

4 player teams, all players tee off. The best drive is selected. (Example Player A's drive is the best, all players move their balls to the location of Player A's drive). Player A doesn't play the next stroke, only Player B, C, D hit second shots. After the best second shot is determined, all players move their ball to that location and Player A rejoins the group and the player whose second shot was used sits out the third shot. Repeat until on the green, then all players will putt.
