From the Pro...

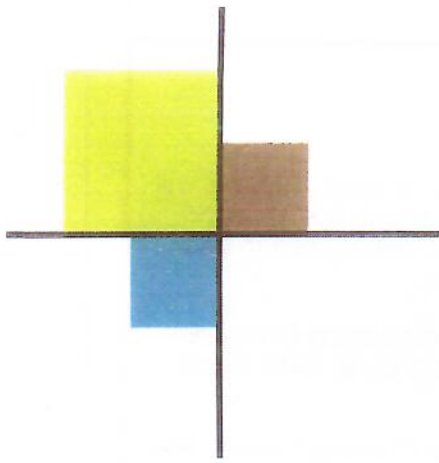
